ADMISSION 2017-2018

Registration form for admission for the academic session 2017-2018 will be available from 1st January 2017 at the reception counter of the school and also on school website <http://www.minilandglobalschool.com>. For online registrations are opened through a link in above website (contact us).

The Registration form should be duly filled in all respects. Parents are requested to submit the registration form to school office with a recent passport size colour photograph of the candidate, father, mother and Registration Fees in cash or through online transaction within two days in filling the registration form. It is advised that parents should fill the registration form themselves to avoid any incomplete information. The applications will be scrutinized and only those found.

ADMISSION PROCESS

List of all successful candidates will be displayed on the notice board of the school. The parents of successful candidates will be required to complete the admission formalities by depositing the required charges along with the necessary documents.

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission :-

1. School leaving/Transfer Certificate and previous year's Report Card (without this no student from class II onwards will be admitted).
2. Medical Certificate issued by a MBBS or higher degree doctor confining the fitness.
3. Birth Certificate, in original, to be brought for verification only (Copy will be retained)
4. Recent passport size colour photograph of the candidate and both parents.

Admission will be cancelled if any variation is found between the particulars filled in the Registration Form and the documents submitted for admission

INTERACTION WITH FOR CLASSES THE PARENTS PRE-NURSERY,NURSERY, PREPARATORY AND CLASS I

Admission to classes Pre-Nursery, Nursery, Preparatory and Class I will be granted on the basis of the interaction. Presence of both the parents during this period is mandatory. No interview of the child will be conducted.

ASSESSMENT AND INTERACTION SESSION FROM CLASS II ONWARDS

Class II onwards, an assessment will be conducted which will be followed by an Interactive Session. Both the parents must be present in the School on the designated day. The entire procedure may last three to four hours. Parents are advised to plan their schedules accordingly.

SYLLABUS OF THE ASSESSMENT

Please note that the syllabus of the assessment for admission has been designed by a professional team of educationists and shall be made available the parents along with the pro speeches.

TRANSPORT FACILITY

We cover main and feeder routes. Specific bus routes will depend on demand and will be determined at the beginning of each academic year. The school reserves the right to fix and/ or change the bus routes as may be necessary from time to time. Parents will be duly informed about the bus routes before the classes commence.

State-of-the-art Classroom, Laboratories,

Our classroom, are spacious and well-ventilated with ample natural and artificial lighting. Ergonomically designed furniture, a combination of green glass and white boards, display boards, teaching aid displays and LCD projection equipment, facilitate the learning process.

Many classrooms have Interactive Smart Class Boards.

Laboratories

- Computer Laboratories: There is one each for the junior and the senior section. These laboratories are well equipped with Internet and multimedia provisions.

- 3 Ultra-Modern Science laboratories with all amenities are there for Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

- Social Science Laboratory is equipped with many models for inculcating interest of students.

Library cum Resource Centre

There are two separate, well-equipped Junior and Senior Libraries, with an extensive range of reference books, newspaper, magazines, periodicals, educational CDs, computer workstations, printer and photocopier.

There is a computer aided referencing system, which enables students to rapidly locate books of their choice.

As part of the focus on e-learning, students are encouraged to use the Internet and to access online International libraries for information.

Inspiring Creativity

Art & Craft

A wide spectrum of visual arts is taught at MGS in its numerous well-equipped Art Studios. E.g. Drawing and Painting, Sculpture, Ceramics, Pottery, Craft, Needle work, Jewellery designing, Computer Graphics, Photography & Textile Designing.

Fine Art: Diverse forms of painting in different mediums are taught and excelled in MGS. Pencil sketching and charcoal shading, crayon colouring and water colour painting are taught extensively here.

At MGS the budding artists also use canvas as a surface to creatively express themselves in oil and acrylic paints for a variety of subjects like landscapes, nature study, still life, portraits and modern impressionistic art etc.

Paper Craft: Diverse forms of paper craft like – Collage-making, Papier-Mache, Origami, Thermocol craft are taught at MGS.

Pottery & Sculpture: At MGS three dimensional art work is undertaken with a variety of substances, e.g. ceramics, clay pottery, stonework, glass casting and fusion, wood and even soft metals – Docra.

Needlework, Applique work and Jewellery Designing: These are some very popular crafts with junior girls at MGS. Their nimble fingers also create cuddly soft toys. Enamel work is also taught to the girls.

Textile Painting: Batik, Block Printing, Fabric Painting and Tie & Dye are some forms of textile painting taught to the students at MGS. The interest generated in this field has motivated many of them to take up fashion and textile designing as a career after school.

Computer Graphics: The development of computer graphics has a profound impact and has revolutionized animation in the student's power point presentations.

Photography: Photography is a hobby in which many students are motivated to explore and experiment.

Music, Dance and Theatre

Both Western and Indian Music styles are taught in equal measure to students at Miniland ... The Global School to develop their skills and musical appreciation.
